Fast Facts Regarding Women in the Automotive and Mobility Industries

- Women comprise of almost half of the U.S. labor force but only represent about 25% of the automotive workforce.¹
- Women of color are especially underrepresented: 6.2% African American women, 1.7% Asian women, and 3.1% Latina women are represented the automotive workforce.²
- A survey conducted in 2019 revealed that of 11 major automakers, none of them had more than 23% women employed in positions of vice-president or higher.^{3, 4}
- Women employed in male-dominated industries face a variety of challenges such as societal expectations about women's leadership abilities, pervasive stereotypes, higher levels of stress and anxiety, and lack of mentoring.⁵

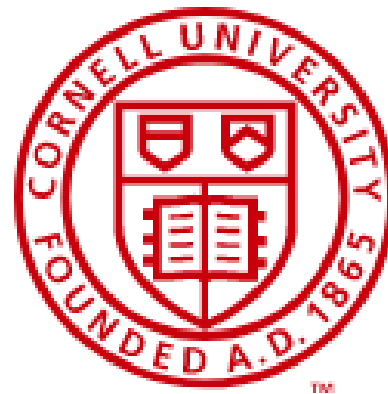
Our current initiative include HER Story, where women in STEM careers share their journey with Detroit area high school students.

Supporting Women is Good Business

If corporations are not proactive in creating and promoting an appealing workplace conducive to gender equality, they might miss vital competitive advantages

- A 2019 study by McKinsey finds that companies in the top quartile for gender diversity on executive teams were 25 percent more likely to have above-average profitability than companies in the fourth quartile
- Going from having no women in corporate leadership (i.e., CEO and other C-suite positions) to a 30% female share is associated with a one-percentage-point increase in net margin, which in turn translates to a 15% increase in profitability for a typical firm.⁶

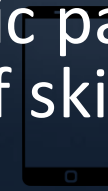
